

Prior to entry to Louee all riders will be required to complete a waiver.

The waiver includes the following acknowledgements, indemnity and recommendations.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS.

Riders must acknowledge that motorcycle riding is dangerous and that engaging in the sport and entering the property it exposes them to certain risks and dangers. They must acknowledge that they may be injured or even killed, that their machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost, stolen or destroyed, that other riders on the property may ride dangerously and with lack of skill, that the tracks may be hazardous, that there are rocks, tree's, stumps, fallen timber and trees, gullies, hills, jumps, ruts and bumps, livestock, including sheep and cattle, wire and steel fences and gates, wildlife and many other hazards and they and many other dangers are so numerous that there may not be warning signs indicating those dangers and they may vary without warning or predictability and that there may be no adequate facilities for treatment or transport for them if they are injured.

INDEMNITY GIVEN TO OWNERS AND ORGANISERS.

They must also agree that they enter and ride on the property **entirely at their own risk. They accept the venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed.** Agree that their admission is subject to the condition that they **indemnify and hold harmless all persons** having any connection with the promotion, organization or conduct of the facility including the owners of the land and the drivers, riders or owners of the vehicles driven or ridden on the land and passengers in or on those vehicles for or in respect of or arising out of their death or any injury, loss or damage to themselves or damage or theft of their machinery/equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.

Due to the dangerous nature of this sport the property owners and organizers **recommend** all riders wear the following **protective clothing.** All riders are required to tick those items that they possess and agree to wear those items at all times whilst riding a motorcycle on the property. The items that are not ticked are those that a rider has personally decided not to purchase and has personally chosen not to wear. All riders must understand that the ticked items are not a guarantee against injury however they have chosen to purchase and wear the protective equipment to assist in reducing any personal injury.

Helmet, Off Road Motorcycle Boots, Goggles, Gloves, Knee Guards, Elbow Guards, Body Armour, Kidney Belt, Specialist riding apparel (Nylons), Spine Protector, Knee Braces, Neck Pad, Camelback.

NOTE. All this equipment is not a requirement for entry to LOUEE. A helmet, covered boots and goggles are essential. We only suggest you wear the above.

Due to Louee not having public risk insurance all riders must also declare that they have purchased **insurance policies**, which will provide for themselves and/or their family financially if they are injured or killed or any of their property is lost, stolen or damaged or destroyed whilst on the land.

MEDICARE, Ambulance Cover, Private Health Insurance, Life Insurance, Third Party Insurance, Comprehensive motorcycle Insurance, Personal Injury Insurance, Permanent Disability Insurance Income Protection Insurance

They must declare that they hold the **one or more** of the above insurance policies and that they are currently valid and that they have decided that the insurance policy or policies will be sufficient to adequately provide for their financial needs should they be injured, killed or any of their property damaged, destroyed or stolen whilst on the property. Riders must have total understanding of the financial impact of any injury or death of him or herself or damage to their property and **absolutely declare that they are sufficiently financially covered for any occurrence and will under no circumstances request reimbursement for loss or damage from any person associated with the property.**
