



# RECOMMENDATIONS & RULES FOR JUNIORS

1. All junior riders must be in the immediate presence, EYE SIGHT of an Adult at all times.
2. If you are bringing a child under 18 years of age that is not your child and intends to ride at Louee, we need to have a "DEED OF APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY GUARDIAN " form signed by the rider's parents/guardians and brought to the track with the rider. You will then be able to sign the child's waiver on behalf of the child's parents. **If you do not bring the completed form the child will not be able to ride.**
3. No junior riders under the age of 18 years are permitted on Enduro trails unless they have a parent or guardian riding with them. It is recommended that the ratio of adults to children be no greater than 2 children to one adult on trails. It is also recommended that trails marked Blue be attempted by children prior to and more difficult level.
4. Junior riders under 18 years of age can ride on the tracks (unless otherwise stated) marked **Blue** provided they are supervised at all times and are wearing a correctly fitting and approved helmet, covered shoes, long trousers and long sleeve shirt. **Joggers are not permitted.**
5. **Riders Under 18 years** of age should only be riding on **Red** tracks if they;
  - a. Have an adequate level of competency for that track.
  - b. Are wearing the clothing listed on our protective clothing sheet.
  - c. Are under the direct supervision of their parents or guardian.
  - d. Are on a Motorcycle with a capacity greater than 80cc.
  - e. Are over the age of 10 years.
6. **Riders Under 18 years** of age should only be riding on **Black** tracks if they;
  - a. Have an adequate level of competency for that track.
  - b. Are wearing the clothing listed on our Protective Clothing sheet.
  - c. Are under the direct supervision of their parents or guardian.
  - d. Are on a Motocross type Motorcycle with a capacity greater than 100cc.
  - e. Are over the age of 12 years.
